Definitions: Check most applicable:

- Farmer/producer** – Someone who has the cost of planting a crop or raising an animal for the intent of income. May make/bake/can/ from their produce for added value sales. May also sell their own meat processed by qualified means that meet health regulations. Food is usually prepared in a home kitchen however, it still must meet the regulated standards. A Food Handlers certificate is preferred.
- Secondary producer** – Grow their own produce to bake/can products usually in a home kitchen. May need to supplement with locally purchased produce to bake/can. A Food Handlers certificate is preferred.
- Artisan/Crafter** – Someone who buys local produce/goods, or imports goods to 100% make/bake/can/blend for the purpose of sale. If it involves food, a commercial kitchen and a Food Handler certificate are preferred and may be given preference.
- Food vendors** – Sales of prepared food for immediate consumption. The prepared food is packaged and kept at proper temperatures as per Health Regulations. A food handler certificate is preferred and will be given preference.
- Resale** – Purchasing a product/produce and reselling at a profit, the same way it was purchased. IE -You buy peaches in Niagara and come to our market to resell them. This requires special permission and must be applied for below to show transparency.

- I grow 70 to 100% of the produce I am asking to sell.
- I bake/can products from my home grown produce.
- I buy locally grown produce to make my jams/pickles/sauces.
- My crafts are 100% made by me.
- My eggs are graded (Have a copy of invoice available).
- I do not resell anything.
- My meat is processed by an inspected abattoir or butcher (Have a copy of meat processing invoice available).
- My baking/canning/food preparation is done in a commercial kitchen. (Have a copy of inspection available).
- I have a food handler certificate (Have a copy available).
- I also sell my products in a store front operation.

Attendance: We are a rain or shine event.

Hours: The Famers Market is scheduled to operate from 2 pm until 6 pm. No vendor shall leave before the schedule finished time as it causes disruption to other vendors and our members.

Set Up and Tear Down: Set up can begin at 1:30 pm on the day of the event and must be completed by 1:50 pm. Tear down can begin at 6 pm and must be completed by 6:30 pm. All garbage must be cleaned up and removed from the property. Vehicles are to be parked at the back of the parking lot as soon as set up is completed. The Club Members Reserved Parking Area and all building fire routes must be kept clear at all times.

Vendor Space: Vendors are provided a space of approximately 7' by 7'.

Supplied Items: The Club will be providing 1 to 2 six foot tables if requested in advance. Limited access to power supply is available. Access must be requested in advance and will be based on the order of received application/payment.

Waivers: Each person attending the event with a Vendor must sign a resort waiver upon arrival at the Club prior to beginning set up.

Food Safety: All vendors supplied food or drink must be in compliance with local Health and Safety Regulations, Liquor Licensing and practice safe food handling procedures. The Club reserves the right to ask a vendor to provide the appropriate certificates or licensing for the event.
