For smooth docking arrangements, visiting boaters are encouraged to establish contact with our Duty Officer on VHF Channel 68 or by calling the club directly at 416-252-7737 shortly before their arrival. Upon successful communication, visiting boats will be promptly assigned to their respective docks. In the event that the Duty Officer is unavailable, visiting vessels are welcome to tie up at our Visitors' Dock, conveniently located in front of the clubhouse, between B Dock and C Dock. Once securely moored, the skipper is kindly requested to register in person with the Duty Officer stationed in the clubhouse.

Our docks are equipped with 30 amp hydro and provide access to potable water, ensuring a comfortable stay for all visiting boaters. Additionally, pump-out facilities are readily available for your convenience. It is worth noting that our harbor boasts considerable depth, providing ample space for vessels of various sizes.
